

Assembly instructions for the Gheenoe Cup Holder by Bateau Co.

This product is specifically designed for Gheenoe boats with Taco Marine vinyl gunnels. It is made from UV-stable engineered plastic in 3 pieces, features stainless steel heat-set inserts, and is assembled with stainless steel screws. Assembly is required. It attaches to the vinyl gunnels without drilling or permanent screws.

What's included:

3 UV-stable engineered plastic pieces with Stainless steel heat set inserts.
Stainless steel screws

Tools needed:

Phillips screwdriver (or appropriate driver for the included screws)
Optional: light lubricant or anti-seize for the screws (marine-grade preferred)

Assembly steps:

Lay out the three plastic pieces. The Gunnel Bracket, Base Plate, and Ring. Match the pieces so the screw holes and inserts line up properly. **Make sure the chamfer in the Gunnel Bracket aligns with the chamfer in the Base Plate, and bump on Ring is on bottom, as shown in photo.**



Insert the 3 stainless steel screws through the aligned holes into the heat-set inserts. Tighten them firmly but do not overtighten—plastic can crack if forced. Snug is sufficient for a secure assembly.

Attach to the Gheenoe:

Clip the assembled holder onto the vinyl gunnel by hooking it on the outside of the gunnel first and then pulling the cup holder down inside the boat. It is designed to secure without drilling or additional fasteners. Position it where convenient (typically along the gunnel for easy reach while seated or standing). Test that it holds securely under light pressure and that a beverage sits stably.
